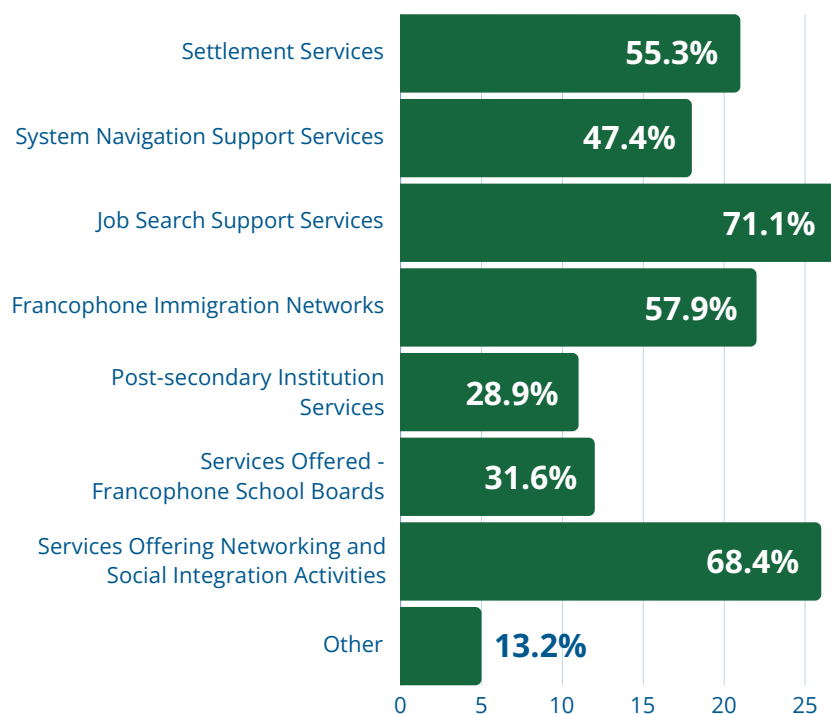


Results - Question of the Month (November)

In your opinion, what are the most important services to offer to foster the integration and well-being of Francophone immigrants in Northern Ontario?

To highlight National Francophone Immigration Week, November's question focused on the services available to Francophone immigrants to support their integration and well-being in Northern Ontario.



The results show that many services are considered important to provide to Francophone immigrants in the region. The most common response—job search support services—demonstrates that financial security is perhaps the top priority for immigrants. Community participation also seems to be a significant priority, as more than two-thirds of respondents selected the option related to networking and social integration activities.

More than half of the respondents acknowledged the importance of settlement service providers and Francophone immigration networks (specifically RIFNO in Northern Ontario). These organizations offer a wide range of direct and indirect services to immigrants, employers, and communities in the region. It is hoped that the reduction in the number of permanent resident statuses granted will not have a significant impact on Francophone service providers in Northern Ontario.
